

# **Directions To Mid County R/C Club's Texan Field**

## **Coming in on I-10 or from the North side of Beaumont:**

- If you are coming in on Interstate 10 from the East Side of Beaumont, continue on through Beaumont following I-10 West until you come to the Port Arthur exit which is Hwy 69 South. Take this exit.
- If you are coming in on Interstate 10 from the West Side of Beaumont, just as you start to come into the outskirts of Beaumont you will come to the Port Arthur exit which is Hwy 69 South. Take this exit.
- Continue south on Hwy 69 for about 5 miles. You will come to an exit that says Nederland, which is Hwy 347, and is also called Twin City Hwy. Take this exit.
- Continue south on Hwy 347 for approximately 3 miles. You will see an ABC Construction Training building on the right hand side. The Welcome to Texan Field sign will be on your left across from the Training Facility. It is a blue sign.
- Turn left and go over the railroad tracks. Continue on for about 200 feet, the road will fork, take the right fork and follow it around until you come to the field.

## **Coming in from Bridge City or Orange:**

- Leave Bridge City on Hwy 73 West heading towards Port Arthur.
- As you come off of the Big Bridge that crosses the Neches River, take the first main exit which is about a mile after you come off of the bridge. It is the Hwy 366 exit.
- Turn right at the stop sign and follow Hwy 366 north, which is also called Pure Atlantic Hwy.
- Stay on Hwy 366 all the way through the city of Port Neches.
- After you leave Port Neches, you will come to an under pass which is where Hwy 347 and Hwy 366 join together.
- After you make the hard right turn going under the underpass, and the road merges with Hwy 347, get in the right hand lane as soon as possible. Go about ¼ mile and you will see the Welcome to Texan Field sign on your right hand side.
- Turn right and go over the railroad tracks. Continue on for about 200 feet, the road will fork, take the right fork and follow it around until you come to the field.
